

Reading Response Prompts Perspective Unit - Week 2

For your reading responses this week, choose a different question to respond to each day. You do not have to respond to the questions in order. When you write your response, make sure you write which letter you chose to respond to. You need to choose a different response to complete each night.

- a. What point of view is your book told in, and **why** do you think the **author** chose the point of view from which your story is told?
- b. Describe a character's perspective on an event – what caused them to think or feel that way?
- c. Do any characters have different perspectives on the same event? What caused them to think or feel differently about the same event?
- d. If you were to preview your book, what information would you gain from using your book's fictional text features (*title, author, illustrator, front cover, back cover, etc.*)?
- e. While you are reading, write down at least four questions that come to your mind.
- f. While you are reading, write down at least two questions that come to your mind, and try to answer your own questions by making inferences.
- g. In the text, find a description about what a character says, thinks, feels, or does, or what others say about them. What does this reveal about the character?

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
