

Reading Response Prompts Perspective Unit - Week 1

For your reading responses this week, choose a different question to respond to each day. You do not have to respond to the questions in order. When you write your response, make sure you write which letter you chose to respond to. You need to choose a different response to complete each night.

- a. Is your book told from the **first person** point of view or **third person** point of view – how do you know?
- b. Is your book told from the **third person limited** or **third person omniscient** point of view – how do you know?
- c. Why do you think the **author** chose the **point of view** from which your story is told?
- d. Is there one voice or **perspective** telling your story, or more than one? Use evidence from the text and explain your thinking.
- e. Imagine your story was told from a **different point of view** (*first to third, or third to first*). Would it change your story at all? Why or why not?
- f. Imagine if a **different character** from the text told your story – how would it change your story? Explain your thinking.
- g. Who is the **narrator** of your story? Describe the narrator using evidence from the text.

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
