Perspective Navigator : Sometimes it is difficult to understand a person's actions or words until we think
about their perspective, or point of view. Your job is to jump into the shoes of a character from your novel, and
explain their perspective on an event that happened while reading. First, you will need to write a short

summary of the event or scene that you will be writing about. Then you will "pretend" to be that character and

write a paragraph to explain their side and view of the event.

Write a brief summary of the event or problem. Be sure to include only "the facts!" Then, choose two characters and compare/contrast how each character felt, thought, or reacted to the event or problem.

Part 2 – After you analyze both characters' perspectives of the event or problem, pose the following discussion questions to your group:

- What is similar and different about the characters' perspectives?
- What do you think influenced each character's perspective? How did their <u>culture</u> or <u>life</u> <u>history</u> affect their perspective?
- In your opinion, whose perspective do you agree with more and why?
